Havana, N. D., June 21.—The All-Nations defeated Havana here Wednesday 5 to 4 in a fast ten-inning game. Havana took the lead from the start and kept it till the eighth when a few bad errors let in the tying run. Havana scored one in the first when Beach, the first man up, singled past short, went to second on Kelly's sacrifice, to third when Burns grounded to third and went home when Reeves pegged to second to get Kelly. Havana scored three more in the third when C. Weber, L. Weber and Leach hit safe; C. and L. Weber scored on Burns' two-base hit and then Leach scored on Holt's sacrifice fly. Mendez started the game, but was relieved by Donaldson in the eighth. Holt worked for Havana in fine style, allowing five hits and struck out nine men.
