SECOND GAME.

The second game of the series was called at 6:30. Palfrey was in the box for Hope and Mendez for the Nations. He pitched air tight ball and at no time was there any chance for Hope. The All Nations made their five runs as follows: First inning, Blatnier walked and went to second on Walla's sacrifice, stole third; Mendez walked, stole second and both scored on Reeves' single. In the third inning, Skaggs was hit by a pitched ball and scored when Castiner doubled to left center. In the fourth inning Blatnier doubled to right center and went to third on Walla's out. Reeves came to bat and placed a single which scored Blatnier. This ended the scoring. Ehred and Miller were the only men on the Hope team that succeeded in securing hits off Mendez and both men died on bases.
