

**LUVERNE 4; ALL NATIONS 1.**

In a gluttonous feast of hits off the supposedly invincible Donaldson, the Luverne Cubs defeated the All Nations club by a score of 4 to 1 Wednesday afternoon at Sibley, Ia., in the presence of approximately 1,500 fans.

It was in the initial inning that Luverne began pounding Donaldson, and before the side could be retired the Cubs had secured five hits and gathered in four scores. And then again in the fifth the Cubs filled the bases, but two strike outs and a grounder retired the side. Two errors and a hit in the eighth enabled the All Nations to push across their lone score.
