

## RELOIT WON AGAIN

### Beat Out Monarchs, 2 to 0 in Hard Fought Contest

The Deloit Leaguers added another victory to their credit yesterday at Sewall park, when the Kansas City Monarchs went down to defeat by a score of 0 to 2.

The game was a tight one throughout and there were various times when it looked like the Monarchs would score one or more, being stopped only by fast plays. On no less than three occasions a dark cloud settled on third base without an out, only to retire without a score. On two of these occasions there was also a tar-drop on second base in addition to the one on third.

ger to right field. Dimond reached first when Blackburn, dropped his fly. Herriott sacrificed, scoring Sutton. Moran hit a sacrifice fly to Donaldson and Hart flew out to Donaldson.
