

TWO WINS FOR MONARCHS

Columbus Buckeyes Trilled in Both Games Yesterday.

The Monarchs took another step toward first place in the National Negro League by winning both ends of a double header with the Columbus Buckeyes at Association Park yesterday. The scores were 5 to 3 and 12 to 1.

Rogan hurled the first game for the home club and was at his best with runners on the paths, ten of the visitors being left stranded on the bases.

In the second game, Mendez and Crawford shared the pitching honors. Mendez toiled for five innings, allowing only one hit in that time. Crawford went to the mound at the start of the sixth and allowed only one more hit during the four innings. The Monarchs batted hard in both contests, getting twelve safe blows in the first game and fourteen in the second.

The final game of the series will be played today starting at 3:15 o'clock. It will be the Monarchs' last game on the home lot for three weeks, as the
