

## THE MONARCHS WON IN TENTH.

### Mendes's Single Drove Home the Run That Beat Giants, 1 to 0.

The Monarchs made a clean sweep in the series with the Chicago Giants, cupping the final battle yesterday, 1 to 0, in ten innings. A single to center by Mendes in the tenth allowed Crawford to score the winning run.

For nine rounds Crawford and Taylor engaged in a hurling duel, Crawford allowing only four scattered hits during the ten innings, while Taylor was nipped for seven base knocks.

The Giants loaded the bases in the ninth, but headwork on the part of Crawford and arduous support by his mates enabled the Monarch leaver to escape with a clean slate. Taylor was in great shape and so two of the Monarch blows came in the same round, while Crawford struck out eleven visitors.

The Monarchs will leave today for St. Louis, where they are scheduled to play two games, before returning home July 24. In case a series with the strong Detroit, Ind. team, the club will play in Indianapolis, Chicago and Detroit. The score
