

## FINAL GAME TO MONARCHS.

Crawford Held Indianapolis A. B. C's to Five Hits in 4 to 1 Contest.

Timely hitting by the Monarchs won the final game of the series with the Indianapolis A. B. C. club yesterday at Association Park, 4 to 1. A tight pitching by Crawford, who held the Indians to five hits also aided materially in the defeat of the visitors. Only three hits were made off Crawford until the ninth when he relaxed and permitted two safe hits which accounted for the visitors' only run. The Monarchs scored three runs in the fourth on hits by Rogers, Arnold Rodriguez and Bertuonda and an error.
