

A single by Mendez in the tenth round which scored Crawford, gave the Monarchs a clean sweep in the series with the Chicago Giants today.

Taylor and Crawford engaged in a pitchers' duel for nine innings, the Monarchs' heavier striking out eleven visitors and yielding only four scattered base knocks. While Taylor was nicked for seven blows, no two of which came in the same inning.
