

MONARCHS WON A SLUGFEST.

The Beloit Leaguers Were Unable to Overcome Big Lead and Lost.

The Monarchs, who were a favorite from the Beloit Leaguers in the opening tilt of the series at Association park yesterday, hitting William freely and hammering up 11 to 10 victory.
