

LOCALS DRUB GOPHERS 6-1; PLAY BRAHAM NEXT

Two hits coupled with four errors after two men were down in the second inning enabled Cambridge to score five runs and clinch the game with the Colored Gophers here Sunday afternoon. A walk and a three-bagger in the third frame resulted in one more run for the Eastern Minnesota Champions, the final score being 6 to 1, the dusky stars making only one tally, in the seventh.

Donaldson, colored hurling ace, was unable to start the game because of recent mound work, but was called into the box in the fifth inning, setting the Cambridge players down in quick fashion, and allowing no hits during his incumbency.

Cambridge made only four hits during the first three innings, while the Gophers garnered six scattered hits during the game off Chell.
