

## BANCROFT WINS BALL GAME

Defeats Fast All Nations Team From Kansas City Last Sunday With a 2 to 1 Score.

Bancroft earned both scores they made.

Bancroft's fast third baseman, Larson, got a home run off Donaldson and Kerwick got a two-bagger.

Manager Wilkinson of the All Nations, a son of our former county superintendent, J. J. Wilkinson, told us Sunday evening that he had no excuses or alibis to offer and that they were fairly beaten. This will probably be the last game of the season on the home grounds as our battery is gone.
