

## MONARCHS WON THE SERIES.

Giants Lost the Final Game Yesterday, 0 to 4.

The Monarchs made it four out of six in the series with the Chicago American Giants, gathering four runs on five safe blows in the final combat yesterday at Association Park and bagging a 4 to 0 victory.
