

BEAT THE CUBS IN NINTH

The Monarchs Came From Behind and Won a 4 to 3 Game.

After baffling the Monarchs for eight innings yesterday in the fourth game of the series, Hernandez, the Cuban pitcher, weakened and allowed three successive hits in the ninth, which filled the bases. La Blanc, star of the Cuban pitching staff, then was sent to the line and hits by Carr and Hogan cleared the bases, the Monarchs winning, 4 to 3. The teams played a tight ball until the sixth when the Cubans jumped into the lead by scoring a run on an infield out and a hit by Jimenez.

The Cubans added two more in the seventh on hits by Alton, Herrera and Jara. In their half of the eighth the Monarchs got their first run on McNear's double, an infield out and a sacri fly by Hogan. The final game of the series will be played today. The score:
