

Cuban Stars Defeat Monarch Club, 6 to 2

The Cuban Stars collected three runs in a fifth-inning rally yesterday, which proved enough to give them the third game of the series with the Monarchs at Association park, 6 to 2.

The Monarchs garnered as many hits off Valdez as their opponents were able to collect off the fast ones of Donaldson and Mendez, but the Cubans bunched their blows and made them count for more runs. The loss of Mathell, regular third baseman, made it necessary for the Monarchs to present a shifted lineup, Mendez going to first and Ornes, a local player, being sent to second.

The Cubans nicked Donaldson for a pair of base knocks in the opening round, which netted them as many runs, while two more blows in the second netted another run. In the fifth, the visitors staged an attack against the Monarch hurler which garnered a trio of counters, and clinched the game. Mendez took the mound in the sixth and kept the enemy well subdued.

The Monarchs counted their first run in the fifth when singles by Portunda and Donaldson sent a run across, while singles by Portunda, McNair and Carr netted another run in the seventh. Mendez will oppose Lopez on the firing line in the fourth game of the series this afternoon.
