

MAPLE DEFEATED THEM.

**American Giants, of Chicago, Beaten
Yesterday by All-Nations by a
Score of 8 to 7.**

One of the very few defeats that have ever been sustained by the American Giants, the strong team of colored baseball players of Chicago, was administered yesterday at Kansas City, Mo., largely through the instrumentality of Rolla Maple, of this city, who did the slab work for the All-Nations team, their opponents. The Giants defeated the All-Nations Saturday and Sunday, Maple having done Saturday's pitching, but they were unable to solve Maple's slants yesterday. However, the game was a very close one, going ten innings before it was finally decided in favor of the All-Nations, by a score of 8 to 7. The latter team, as its name indicates, is made up of players of many different nationalities.

The American Giants are a wonder-

ful team. It is said that they have sustained only 250 defeats in a total of 3,000 games played. They have several pitchers who are wonders, and who if they were white men, would doubtless be leaders on the pitching staffs of the big leagues.
