

ALL NATIONS HAVE MADE GREAT RECORD ON ROAD THIS YEAR

Sidney, Mont., Aug. 3.—The All Nations won three out of four games from the Williston club; two of the series of four games were played at Williston and two at Sidney.

Williston won the first game by a score of 8 to 0; the other three were won by the All Nations by scores of 1 to 0, 10 to 3, and 7 to 4.

The All Nations out-hit the Williston club in all but the first game. Browning of Williston won one game and lost one; Ruhl and Marshall lost one game each. Donaldson, Mendez and Wilkus each won a game for the All Nations.

The All Nations have not lost a series this season, and now have a record for the season of 89 games played, of which three were tie, eight lost and 78 won.

Considering that all these games have been played on the road and against the best salaried clubs in the west it is a record that will stand for some time for a traveling club.
