The colored ball team from Fayette, were defeated Monday afternoon by the Hannaca Blues, the score being 5 to 1. Wes Donaldson pitched for the Blues and struck out 15 men. John Vivion pitched the first five innings for the Fayette tribe, but only struck out one man and was batted so freely they took him out and substituted Lee Marshall, who had even less luck than Vivion. The Blues played a fast game, not allowing one of the Fayette boys to reach third, and only one got to second, and that on a passed ball. The Blues made several two-baggers and Orae Jones batted the ball out to the wire fence in right field, making three bases on the hit. The score by innings:
