Bentley started the game for Jamestown, but his arm went lame and Cole went in. He was touched up for several hits, and with a few errors the tale is told. Jamestown got one run off of Donaldson, in the sixth Low hit to center for three sacks and scored when Elder sent a sacrifice fly to right field. The feature of the game was the pitching of Donaldson, who struck out 18 batters. He also struck out 15 the night before, making 33 strikeouts in two nights, which is a new record.
