Donaldson worked easily at all times, striking out 17 men and allowing four hits, no Schuyler men reaching third. Codner hit to the center field fence for a homer in the third, the longest hit ever made on the local lot. Shanks of Clarks umpired the game, his clean-cut, snappy work justified his reputation as the best in the state.
