Rochester's baseball season opened auspiciously Sunday. The day was fair but not overly warm and two excellent teams were arrayed against each other. Rochester gave a good account of itself, even though the All-National aggregation did defeat the locals by the score of 4 to 0.

The All-Nation team is rated as one of the fastest in the country and with the famous negro pitcher, Donaldson, on the mound for the visitors, Rochester did very well to hold the score down to four. Donaldson's pitching was remarkable. He held the locals to only two hits and was credited with 8 strikeouts.

But Dunfee of Austin, was also the surprise of the day. He was in fine form and twirled an elegant game for the locals. He allowed only five hits to the Nations and also landed eight strikeouts.

Rochester was somewhat prolific on errors, getting six. Crow, playing the second sack, had hard luck and had three errors chalked up to him.

The game was witnessed by one of the largest crowds in years, and the scene resembled the good old days of

the Minny league.
