Before one of the largest crowds ever gathered for a baseball game at the Decotah Park at Grand Forks, Sunday afternoon, Warren again suffered defeat at the hands of the All Nations team. This time it was through the wonderful throwing of John Donaldson, the world's greatest negro pitcher. Donaldson was at his best and nabbed 18 men at the home plate. Lefty Halbert was on the mound for Warren and threw an excellent game. Grand Forks fans were greatly pleased by the manner in which he held his strong opponents down to seven hits, all of which were singles.

Though Warren was defeated, they gave their opponents a merry chase and time and again the Warren men were applauded for brilliant playing.
