Concordia will be treated to a real ball game Sunday when the All Nation's aggregation meet Ike Soule's Simpson-Leaguers at Laing's Park. J. E. Gaul, one of the owners of the team, was in Concordia yesterday and he made the statement that John Donaldson, the famous negro pitcher will be on the mound against the leaguers.

An enormous crowd was in town yesterday to witness the ball game between the Simpson Leaguers and the All Nations which resulted in a victory for the latter by a 11 to 3 score. However, the score should not have been more than 6 to 3, but two hits which should not have gone for more than one base were lost in the crowd, one happening when three men were on bases. It was a good game for those who liked plenty of hitting for 12 hits were registered by each side, those for the All Nations coming at opportune times. The crowd was so large that it interfered materially with the game, and some estimate it at 2,000 people. Cars from all the surrounding towns were here and the downtown district looked like a busy Saturday afternoon just before fair time. From here the two teams went to Washington for a game and from there they will tour northern Kansas.
