Los Angeles, Cal., Dec. 21.—The Los Angeles White Sox opened their winter season Sunday, Dec. 9, against the champion San Pedro Merchants. Donaldson, the All Nations left hander, and Pete Schendler, of the Cincinnati Reds, hooked up into a grand pitching duel. Donaldson outpitched the big Red pitcher, striking out sixteen men and allowing 6 hits and 3 runs, while the Sox got to Schendler for 10 hits and 5 runs. The San Pedro club was composed of all big league players. Both clubs played a grand fielding game. The White Sox' new infield was composed of Mendez, the Cuban, ss, and Mallascher of the A. B. C.'s at third base and Perry at second, while Carr was on first base. It looks very good. Manager Goodwin does not think he will have any trouble in winning the winter league championship.
