Donaldson was then called in to the box but Markuson singled off him, scoring Richards and tying the count. Rasmussen struck out to end the inning. In the first half of the tenth the All Nations went out in order. Cherokee started off right in the last half of the inning when Olson singled to right, Slattery sacrificed sending Olson to third, Quinn had been pitching the inning but he was taken out and Donaldson called again. Rogers greeted him with a hit over the right fielders head scoring Olson and winning the game 6-5.
