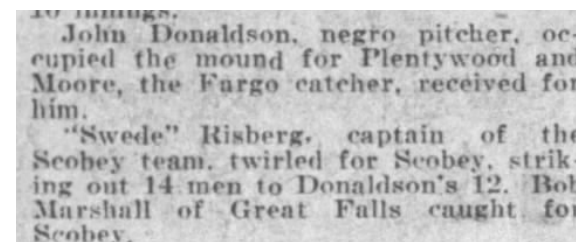

Scobey to bat: Dallas walked. Seifert out to pitcher and a double to first caught Dallas. Risberg hit safe. Felsch struck out. 1 hit, no runs.

Plentywood: Smith walked. Gullickson struck out. Molle flew out to Felsch. Donaldson struck out. No hits, no runs.

2. Marshall struck out. Guyer went out. 3rd to 1st. Eastman struck out.

Moore out, 3rd to 1st. Hub singled. Mattick out, 3rd to 1st. O'Donnell singled, scoring Hub. Linn out to Guyer unassisted. 2 hits, 1 run.

3. Myers struck out. Hilden singled and stole second. Dallas struck out. Seifert out, short to 1st. 1 hit, no runs.

Smith struck out. Gullickson struck out. Molle out, short to 1st.

4. Risberg singled, stealing second. Felsch clouted a safe one over second and kept the ball in play while Risberg stole home, tying the score. Marshall went out to 1st and "Happy" got nabbed stealing 3rd. Guyer struck out. 2 hits, 1 run.

Donaldson bunted to 3rd reached 1st on an error, and stole second on a raw decision. Moore struck out and Donaldson stole 3rd. Hub out, 1st to

2nd. Mattick flew out to short. No hits, no run.

5. Eastman out, 2nd to 1st. Myers struck out. Hilden beat his bunt stole second and went to 3rd on an overthrow. Dallas struck out.

O'Donnell, Lind and Smith were struck out by Risberg.

6. Seifert flew out to the right pasture. Risberg out to pitcher unassisted. Felsch "Ruth"fully socked one over the center boundary and took two bases. Marshall struck out. 1 hit, no runs.

Gullickson flew out to right field. Molle struck out. Donaldson out, Risberg to Guyer.

7. Guyer flew out to 3rd. Eastman struck out and Myers flew out to center field.

Moore out, 3rd to 1st. Hub flew out to center. Mattick out, 3rd to 1st.

8. Hilden fanned. Dallas got another walk. Seifert out, pitcher to 1st and Risberg the same.

O'Donnell and Chekaluk struck out and Smith flew out to Hilden.

9. Felsch flew out to center. Marshall got 3 strikes and reached 1st on Gullickson's error. Guyer grounded to short and a double to 2nd and 1st retired the side.

Gullickson singled. Molle out on foul fly to Guyer. Donaldson singled. Moore got a pass to first when hit by pitched ball. Hub flew out to 2nd who also caught Moore off first for a saving double.

10. Eastman singled. Myers reached first on fielder's choice and Eastman went out at second. Myers pilfered second and scored on Hilden's drive to right field. Dallas walked. Seifert struck out. Risberg drove his third hit into center, scoring Hilden and Dallas. Felsch went out, pitcher to first. Three hits; three runs.

Mattick reached first on short's error. BASEBALL—Plentywood vs. Scobey ror, but O'Donnell, Chekaluk and Smith struck out, ending the inning and the game.
