Worthington took a first inning lead with one run and held it until the third when the House of David team counted twice. The House of David team counted one run in the fourth, fifth and sixth innings each and led 5 to 1 when the locals went to bat in the sixth. The locals rallied in that inning and had Freeman, House of David pitcher, looking weak. John Donaldson replaced Freeman and Worthington was quickly retired, but three runs had come in to make the score 5 and 4.

The House of David team took two hits and two runs in the seventh and the locals were unable to score in their last time at bat.

The game was an interesting one and well played for the most part by both teams. The House of David nine was composed of heavy hitters and clever fielders. The batters nicked Ray Smith for 12 hits while Worthington secured eight from Freeman's delivery and one from Donaldson. Spillman and Reeves each secured two hits and Sowles, Thompson and Smith each got one hit.
