

LONG HITS WON FOR MONARCHS.

The Cuban Stars Were Defeated in Final Series Game, 2 to 3.

Long hits with men on bases gave the Monarchs the final game of the series with the Cuban Stars at Association park yesterday, 2 to 3. Carr's pair of doubles and McNear's triple were the paramount factors in the defeat of Lullback, the Cuban "iron man," the three hits being responsible for the Monarch score.

Carr's first double, which came in the first inning, and McNear's hit put the first run across. Carr's second double, in the third, which followed a hit by Portunillo, sent the latter to third. He scored on Donaldson's sacrifice fly to Kero. The Cubans started a rally in the sixth and tied the score on hits by Dick and Barr, two bases on balls and an infield out. In the ninth McNear tripled to center. Rogan then won the game by hitting safely scoring McNear.
