HUMBOLDT LOSES LONG GAME.

Humboldt, Iowa, Sept. 15.—Brown's Tennessee Rats, the colored team that has defeated so many of Iowa's semi-professionals this season, defeated Humboldt in one of the sensational games of the season in eighteen innings. Dye, who has gained such a reputation for himself this year, pitched airtight ball for Humboldt. Donaldson twirled for the negroes. The same teams played here yesterday in an eleven-inning game, which was won by Humboldt.

John Wesley Donaldson writes from Humboldt, Ia., under date of September 14, as follows: "I pitched an 18-inning game here 4 to 3. I struck out 31 men, and not a hit made from the seventh to the eighteenth inning. I'll be home in a few days."
